An AED is an Automated External Defibrillator. It is a lifesaving device that can help to re-start the heart. The Louis T. Savino, III Foundation (www.savinofoundation.org) is a nonprofit, 501(c)3 organization that raises money for the placement of AEDs at athletic fields, schools and youth camps. The foundation, established in 2000, is dedicated to increasing awareness of HCM (hypertrophic cardiomyopathy) and preventing sudden cardiac death in high school athletes.

Louis T. Savino, III died at the young age of 15 on October 12, 2000 on a soccer field in Yardley, Pennsylvania during a practice session for his favorite sport, soccer. Louis died of an undetected, misdiagnosed congenital heart condition known as *hypertrophic cardiomyopathy (HCM)*. An AED, had it been available, may have saved his life.
